



# CHURT JUNIORS FC TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2025

## Section 1 – Parental / Guardian Help

By registering a child with the club, all parents agree that they will help with one or more of the below activities on a regular basis:

- setup and take down goal posts (both for practice and matches)
- act as linesman (in relevant age groups)
- work on the CJFC Committee
- help coach.

## Section 2 – Disclaimer of liability

1. Churt Juniors FC assumes no responsibility or liability for any injury/ damage to any person, persons or property, whether resulting from taking part in any activity of the club or otherwise.
2. CJFC will use all reasonable endeavours to contact the parent/ guardian or emergency contact in the event of illness or injury.

## 3. Section 3 – Club Code of conduct

Churt Juniors FC is a Charter Standard Club.

Please remember that parents and coaches give up their free time to help so all players must show respect. Inappropriate behaviour may result in players and/ or parents being barred from training sessions and matches at the club's discretion.

**Churt Juniors FC follows the FA “Code of Conduct” for players, parents and spectators which needs to be signed by both players and their parent or guardian.** The player *and* parent must sign the player form. A parent must sign the parent and spectator form. These can be obtained from the relevant age group coach. They can be emailed to you if requested.

## **Section 4 – Photography**

CJFC follows the FA recommended guidelines on photography. These can be found on the FA website, the Churt Juniors FC web site or can be obtained from your coach.

By registering a child with the club, parents:

- (i) acknowledge that it is not an offense to take appropriate photos in a public place, even if asked not to, and that no one has the right to decide who and who cannot take photos on public land;
- (ii) understand, acknowledge and agree that photos of their child may be taken in the course of playing for Churt Juniors FC; and agree that photos of their child may be used by the club on the club website and social media platforms.

## **Section 5 – Video policy**

The club's Video Recording and Filming Consent Policy is available on the club website.

The policy is consistent with the NEHYL policy on taking images and videos during matches - <https://nehyl.org.uk/taking-images>. As part of the process of annual registration, parents must indicate whether or not they consent to videoing of their child. This consent can be withdrawn at any time by giving notice in writing to the relevant age group coach for that player.

## **Section 6 – Data privacy**

Churt Juniors FC collects and holds personal data of players with the club and their parents. The way in which Churt Juniors FC uses such personal data is set out in the club's Membership Data Privacy Statement, which is available on the Churt Juniors FC website.
